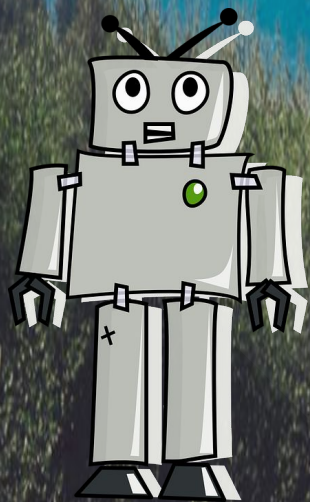

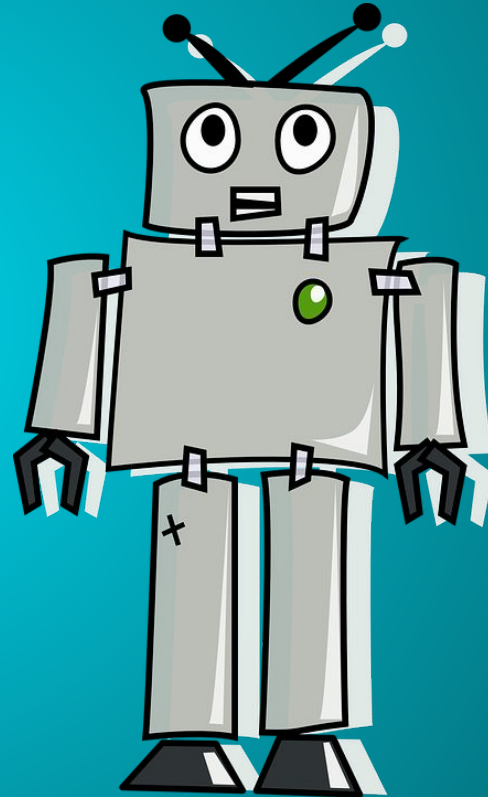


Directions

The students are put thru a rigorous week of studying.

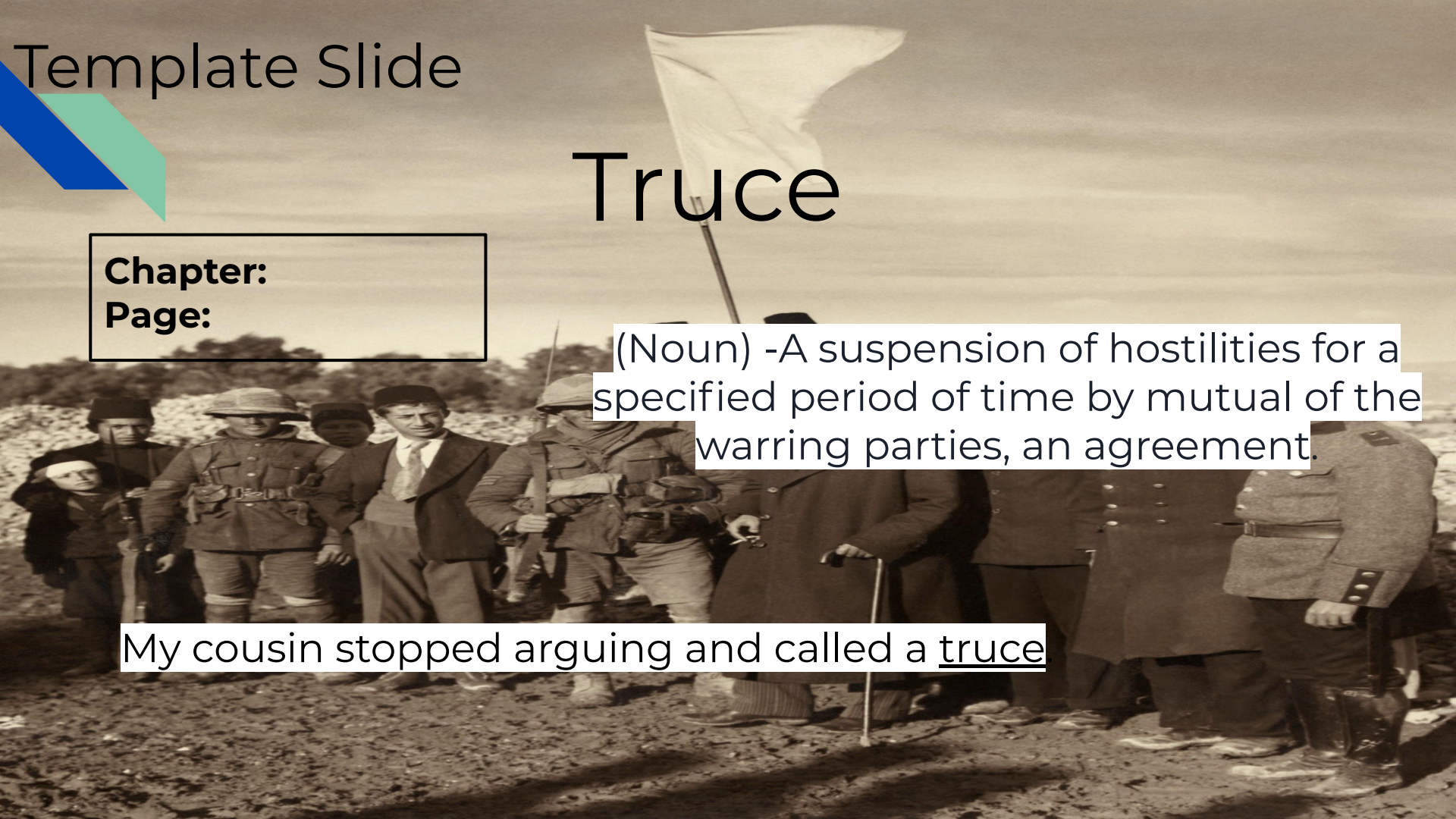
Truce
